11:30am: Registration Open:

All participants to make sure they arrive at the club **no later than 11:30am**. We aim to use shotgun format to get the day underway. It's important that we have the teams all checked in by **11:30am** or just after. A lunch box with soft drink and also a goody-bag will be handed to every participant at registration. **Guest locker rooms are available to use for the day.**

12:00pm - 1:00pm: Warm-up: Walk-the-Line Wyndance Golf Pro will be there to help all Players

The entire practice area – range, chipping/sand-bunker, putting – will be dedicated to TGN between 12:00pm to 1:00pm. After the registration, you can head up to warm up. A photo/video session will be happening during this time to take the individual & foursome pictures/videos.

1:10pm - 1:30pm: Tee-Off and Commencement of the round:

Shot-gun start will take place exactly at 1:30pm. A group will start at every hole. Please gather in front of the club house exactly at 1:15pm. Your power carts will be labeled with your names and the hole number you will be starting from. Wyndance back staff will guide all Golfers to their respective holes and the **shot gun will go off at 1:30pm**

A Beverage Cart will be roaming around the Golf Course for your indulgence.

6:30pm: Post Tournament BBQ Meal with a Drink & Presentations

Players and Guests will be gathering at the Patio to enjoy a full BBQ Buffet meal with a drink. Cash bar will be open during this time as well.

A short presentation ceremony will be taking place to recognize the Sponsors, Winners and Volunteers.

DRESS CODE The Club is quite strict with its dress code. There are only 3 simple rules

- **Golf Shorts** are fine, but socks must cover your ankles; no jeans allowed on the course
- Smart golf attire on the course (shirts with a collar etc.)
- Casual attire (no jeans) for the post tournament BBQ

TOURNAMENT FORMAT, SCORING & COURSE MANEUVERING

Event Format: Scramble Foursome (A Captain will be assigned for each Foursome)

In this format, it is a basic scramble off the tee of each hole, after the best tee shot is selected, everyone proceeds to play their 2nd shot from there. The next best shot is again selected, and everyone places their balls at that location (you can place the ball within the length of a scorecard). This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

****Minimum of two drives per golfer over the 18 holes must be used****

****The two drives of each golfer must be indicated on the hardcopy scorecard****

Teams with Three Players; just in case if there is a no show

If the group consists of three people, four shots must still be taken. After each person has hit his first tee shot, a member of the team must hit a fourth ball off the tee. The person who hits this ball must continue to hit an extra shot until the ball is holed.

At the second tee, another member of the group must be selected to hit the fourth ball. This player CANNOT be the same player who hit the fourth ball on the last hole. This three-player rotation must be followed throughout the entire round.

The best score for the group will act as the 'Team score'. Please mark the team score on the scorecard for each hole to create your event score after 18 holes.

Golf Genius & Scoring

Hardcopy customized scorecards will be printed and placed in your power carts. We have deployed Golf Genius for scoring and tracking purposes. **Please download 'Golf Genius App'** beforehand and a GGID will be assigned to each group to make scoring seamless. Only one person per group needs to enter the score using Golf Genius. It is also mandatory to keep the score on the hardcopy scorecard and hand it over to the tournament organizing officials at the end of the round with the Captain's signature.

Course Maneuvering

- **Please obey the entry and exit point for the power carts** on each hole which are marked with black stakes; Powercarts on cart path only on Par 3s. Powercarts are on cart path only around the greens and tee boxes
- Hole #16: power carts are on cart path only, the slopes are steep and please do not take any chances
- Please try to repair fairway divots and ball marks on the green
- For fairway divots, please use the divot mix found in the white containers on the power carts. If you run out of the divot mix, there are numerous stations where you can refill the divot mix
- On course washrooms are available at hole #6 & #14; cool water fountain at half-way house
