

ANNUAL GOLF CLASSIC



(Wednesday, July 26th, 2023)

RULES AND DETAILS

All players will be placed into a well-balanced foursome. Men will play from **White tees** and women will play from **Red tees.**

- Each team will be balanced and grouped by the tournament committee; they will select the teams on a random basis
- A Team Captain/Anchor will be appointed by the Tournament Committee to facilitate with scoring, pace-of-play, rules, etc.
- The usual golf etiquette rules apply at all times
- This tournament will be conducted under the double-par rule; i.e. on a par four hole, the maximum score will be 8. After 8 shots, you simply pick up the ball and head to the next hole
- **Divots** if your ball is landed in **divots on the fairway**, you are allowed to pick and clean the ball and place it within two putter lengths, **PUTTER HEAD, NOT THE SHAFT**, away from the pin/flag
- **Puddle-of-Water/Repair area** if your ball lands in one of these areas, you are allowed to pick and clean the ball and move it to the closest playable area, with your playing partners' consent, away from the pin/flag
- Please putt everything out... no 'give me's! This makes it fair for everyone
- There will be no preferred lies anywhere
- Wasteland, you are allowed to ground your club and take practice swings; you are also allowed to pick, clean and place the ball away from the flag up to one club length
- Tournament Rule for cart-path/man-made objects/sprinkler-heads relief: if your line of attack, stance or swing path is interfered with these objects, you are allowed to move the ball to the nearest playable area, with your playing partners' consent, no closer to the hole. Trees are not considered man-made objects and no relief is permitted, you can move the ball to the nearest playable area, with your playing partners' consent, no closer to the hole with a penalty stroke
- Stake Rules: all stakes, red/yellow/whites/no-stakes, you are allowed to drop a ball at the point-of-entry away from the flag with a one-stroke penalty
- All novice Golfers are allowed to use the tee anywhere on the Golf course except for the greens
- If at the end of the round, any unused tee-shots from the minimum requirement will be added to the final score of that team; i.e. 2 unused tee-shots will mean 2 penalty shots being added to the final score
- To improve Pace of Play, the Captains will guide you on the course when needed

It will be a terrific day!! We play ...rain or shine !! Have your rain gear in the bag depending on the weather forecast
